



Mission Minded

"I knew that I could make a difference in my life and the lives of others."

Cheree Chelette is a woman with a mission ... or two, or more. Like many who pledged to do more for their country following the 9/11 terrorist attacks, Cheree has since followed through on several life-changing goals. "Late in 2001, after the tragedy of 9/11, I was laid off from the travel industry. I decided to return to college and complete my degree in education.

After much hard work, I began my teaching career," Cheree said.

Following a challenging first year, Cheree felt trapped in a bad situation. "My first year teaching was a lot different than I expected, and I did not know what to do. I had spent all of this time and money, and I felt that I had no option but to try and survive," she remembered.


While continuing to substitute teach in Mansfield Independent School District, Cheree experienced something that improved her outlook. "I first started doing mission work while attending Lake Arlington Baptist Church in 2002. We put on a Vacation Bible School for children in a lower-income area in Fort Worth that summer," Cheree said. In the fall of 2002, she took a mission trip to Maryland, coordinating a fall festival for New Hope Community Church. "We went to do outreach in the community, help with clean-up in the church and to put on the festival," Cheree explained. "It was a great time spent with people trying to make a difference in their community."

By 2005, Cheree was teaching in the Fort Worth Independent

School District and was ready for an even greater mission. With her church's youth group, she volunteered at an orphanage in Jamaica, helped build classrooms for a school for deaf children and held a VBS for children in the community. "It was a very humbling experience. We stayed at the school, with no air conditioner and no hot water. We ate their food and slept where the children would normally stay during the school year. We held children, played with them and rocked babies at the orphanage. What a heartbreak thing to see, but a blessing to be part of," Cheree expressed.

Touched by the work in Jamaica, Cheree made another career change. "I currently work part time at Mansfield Bible Church as the receptionist. I took this job because I love volunteering at my church and felt it was a great opportunity to get more involved in children's ministry and missions," she said. To that end, Cheree decided to give thanks for what mission work has given her on Thanksgiving Day 2008. "Two of my sisters and I participated in the Turkey Trot Thanksgiving morning in Fort Worth. We ran the 5K to help raise money for the Salvation Army,"

Cheree said. After the race, the sisters picked up other family members and went to Mission Arlington. "We helped deliver meals to people who had no one to celebrate with, nor did they have a Thanksgiving meal. After delivering meals, we helped load and unload trucks of food that had been donated for people in need," Cheree added. "It made me realize how

truly blessed I am."

The experience prompted Cheree to focus on volunteerism close to home. "I recently teamed up with a few other members of our church to create a mission team, and my part was to plan mission opportunities. I have planned one project for our church families to be involved in every month," Cheree said. "This will build up to and prepare people for one long-distance mission trip a year, [the first being in] the summer of 2010." Timothy 2:15 — and Vacation Bible School programs at her church.

Cheree uses the insight she has gained through these programs, and from the recent breakup of her own marriage, to help others through whatever difficulty they are facing. "My goal is to do what I can to help others get back on their feet; whether it's feeding them, clothing them, helping them with a project, giving encouragement, or the hope that they need to continue to move forward in their life journey," she said.

she said. Cheree also enjoys to camp, water or snow ski, read, cycle, and spend time with friends and family.

While Cheree hopes to build a family of her own someday, she plans to always keep God the focus of her life and be open to wherever He leads her. "I feel that it is only by God's grace that any of us have anything," she explained. "It all belongs to God, and if I were to be selfish with my time or money, then God could choose to take it all away."

Cheree's track record proves she is anything but selfish. "I get great satisfaction and fulfillment by helping others and feeling like I might have made a difference in someone's life," she



shared. "I feel that the best way to reach people and help meet their needs is to meet them where they are at. It's all about loving them and helping them in a practical way." Pilgrims and Patriots

Duane and Kathy Murray are many things to many people. He, a former mayor of Mansfield and president/owner of his own business and she, a successful entrepreneur and business owner, have been leaders in the community for decades. They have been pioneers, extremely active in their church as well as participating in charitable works and local politics.

After a recent trip to Israel with their pastor and fellow parishioners from the First Methodist Church of Mansfield, both Duane and Kathy were humbled

by what they saw. "When you read the Bible and realize you are where Moses once was, that you are at Mt. Tabor..." Kathy's voice trailed off for a moment. "It's amazing." Just to stand on the grounds of the Chapel of Dominus Flevit on the Mount of Olives or to gaze out upon the Sea of Galilee or even to be near the walls of Jericho, believed to be the oldest known walled city in the world, was utterly amazing for this couple.

Though they are deeply committed to their own spiritual beliefs, they also embraced the customs of an Arab Muslim

bus driver and Palestinian tour guide. "We went thinking we were American tourists, but then suddenly realized we were pilgrims," Kathy said.

In truth, Duane and Kathy have been on a journey together for a lifetime. Through the close friendship of their parents, Duane and Kathy have known each other all their lives, as evidenced by a cherished black-and-white photo of Kathy at age 2 and Duane, 12, riding a pony together. By her early teens, Kathy kept Duane's senior high school picture on her vanity, "and my sister once said, 'You're going to marry Duane,'" she recalled. When Duane joined the U.S. Navy and his parents moved from their small Iowa town to Texas, however, it seemed unlikely the young couple would meet again, until Kathy moved in with Duane's parents to work in a bank in Irving, Texas.

Charles Perrault when he wrote his novel, *Sleeping Beauty*. During the September 11 attacks, Duane and Kathy had been visiting that very place when "a Frenchman approached us and said, 'Your country is under attack!' It was terrible. This summer, as they plan yet another trip, this time on their Harley Davidson, they have decided to return to their patriotic roots. Concerned about local politics, Duane ran for mayor of Mansfield in 1994 and won, holding his term until 1997, when he decided to return to the private sector full time. "But I've always said if you're going to be vocal, you need to step up," Duane said. "If you don't do it, who else is going to do it?" With renewed concerns about the economy and politics, both Duane and Kathy have joined a grassroots organization in hopes of helping their community and nation where they can. Whether patriot or pilgrim, keeper of sacred pictures or owners to a thieving golf ball snatcher, Duane and Kathy are most assuredly many things to many people, and we are all the more grateful to them. **TODAY**

Moving On

Kristen Lynn was just 9 years old the first time she remembers being told to give up on her dream. She did not listen. In fact, three years later, Kristen Lynn wrote her first song. It was at the tender age of 5, when she heard the song "My Heart Will Go On," that she became serious about singing. "I remember hearing that song, and I fell in love with music. That's when I knew I wanted to be a singer," she said. "It's true," her mother, Sandy Love-Gilbert, laughed. "She came to me."

Jimmy has always been supportive of me. When I was a little girl, Jimmy was the one who always told me I could do whatever I wanted to do. I feel very lucky to have him," she expressed.

All of Kristen Lynn's hard work is paying off. After almost a decade of working with a voice coach, performing on stage, attending the Creative Art Theatre and School and the Art Institute of Mansfield, Kristen Lynn has found her niche in

the country music genre. Both Kristen Lynn and her mother agreed that her voice is better suited for country music. "Plus I'm not really into hip-hop and rap music," she said. The family worked hard to save up money to cut Kristen Lynn's first demo. "We sent it out to every record label we could find," Kristen Lynn added.



Because the Avengers are not a school team, Taylor works out on her own time to stay physically fit during off season. "I just try to make sure I don't gain any weight and keep the muscle tone that I have," she explained. When the season is in full swing, Taylor attends two-a-days every Sunday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Her dedication and passion for the



game have not only allowed her to travel extensively, but have also inspired her to reach out to and touch the country on behalf of the sport that she loves. Last year, combining her knowledge of softball and baseball with a school project through Distributive Education Clubs of America (DECA), and with the help of fellow classmate Adam Floyd, Taylor discovered an entrepreneurial spirit she did not know she had. During her senior year, Taylor was president of her DECA chapter, and she competed at the international level with the project that got the ball

The Key to Success

To say that Kathy Starr experienced something of a culture shock when she began teaching in the United States is a bit of an understatement. "Living in the Philippines is very different compared to living here in the U.S.," Kathy said. "There the [school] rooms are very crowded. They put 50 students or more in a classroom, and there aren't enough books and chairs for all the kids. There is no such thing as a free lunch. Whether you are rich or poor, you have to bring your food." It is not uncommon for children to go hungry during the day as there is no lunch program. The school system also does not pay for transportation. "Only rich people have cars," Kathy said. Most people must pay to use the public transportation or "jeepney" (a small bus converted from a jeep). Once children are over the age of 7, they can be seen using the jeepney to get to and from school each day.

Computers are a privilege, although there is no Internet access available to the classrooms. There is no air conditioning and only the most rudimentary teaching tools are available to teachers. What the Filipino students do have, however, is desire. In a country as poor as the Philippines, education is treasured. It is seen as a gift and a way to excel.

"I grew up in a very poor family," Kathy said. "My family couldn't afford to send me to college." She was able to get a scholarship from the Department of Science and Technology. After graduation, Kathy began teaching fourth-grade math, making just \$150 a month. Though challenging, she loved her job and her students.

For fun, Kathy had created a profile on a dating Web site. Many of her friends had done the same thing and had urged Kathy to try it. While this very pretty woman garnered much attention on the Web site, it was a handsome young school teacher in Texas who caught her attention. At the time, Tracey Starr had been teaching in southern Texas, near the Mexican border. "I was a single father, raising my daughter by myself and living in remote South Texas," Tracey laughed. "I was



pretty limited in meeting eligible singles." While curiosity had lured Kathy to the dating Web site, Tracey simply hoped to find someone with similar family values and work ethics who would be willing to share a life with his daughter.

Kathy and Tracey began talking online and by phone for hours and hours. They exchanged pictures and letters and after seven months of courting long distance, Tracey traveled to the Philippines to meet Kathy and her family. Ten days later, they were engaged and making arrangements for Kathy to come stateside. After three years of teaching, Kathy headed to the United States for a new life and career.

When Tracey relocated to Mansfield, Texas, Kathy began looking at all teaching positions in the area. "I had to redo all my teaching certifications to teach here in Texas," she said, explaining that she quickly landed a job teaching ninth grade in Cedar Hill.

Tracey's experience soon proved invaluable. Also a high school teacher at Ben Barber Career and Technology Academy, Tracey helped Kathy transition into a new school system. "Since I've been teaching longer than she has, I could give her that experience, especially when dealing with American students," he pointed out.

"She really cares about her students," Tracey said. "She wants to see them be successful and help them get excited about learning, and she's always giving me ideas to integrate

computer technology into my own classroom." Still, cultural attitudes were challenging. "Discipline issues weren't the same in the Philippines," Kathy said. "Here in America, we have to deal with kids who are sometimes more reluctant learners."

When an opening for a technology education teacher opened at Danny Jones Middle School in Mansfield, Kathy leapt at the chance. "I could teach in Mansfield with my husband, and we



could have the same schedule," she said. It was the ideal situation for the young couple who love to travel in their RV. "Last summer, we went to Colorado and stayed for two months," Tracey said. With their 3-year-old son, Kacey, and Tracey's 16-year-old daughter, Traci, summertime is family time.

The move to a different school district also meant more than just a convenient schedule for Kathy. "I really love the other teachers at Danny Jones," she expressed. "They really made me feel at home, and they welcomed me as one of them. I never felt like an outcast. I was part of the family right away."

The going joke is that because of her petite size and youthful appearance, she looks like one of the students. For Kathy, it is yet another way to connect with her students. Whether she is sharing her prized Beanie Baby collection or being mistaken as one of the students in the hallway, she is determined to pass along one truth from her Filipino heritage: Education is a true gift that will always grow if nurtured. **NOW**

Look Who's Cooking

IN THE KITCHEN WITH TRACEY PIM

KEY LIME PIE

2 10-oz. cans sweetened condensed milk
1/2 cup sour cream
3/4 cup Key lime juice
1 Tbsp. grated lime zest
1 prepared graham cracker crust, 9-inch

Preheat oven to 350 F. Combine condensed milk, sour cream, lime juice and lime zest. Mix well and pour into graham cracker crust. Bake in preheated oven for 5-10 minutes, until tiny pinhole bubbles burst on the surface of pie. Do not brown! Chill thoroughly before serving. Serve with lime wedges and whipped topping, if desired.

SHIRLEY TEMPLE CUPCAKES

16-oz. jar Maraschino cherries (no stems)
4 cups flour
2 tsp. baking powder
1 1/2 cups butter
2 cups sugar
4 eggs

2 tsp. vanilla
1 tsp. fresh lemon juice
1 tsp. fresh lime juice
1/2 cup milk
1/2 cup reserved cherry juice

FROSTING:

1 cup butter, softened
1 cup shortening
1/4 tsp. lime zest
1/4 tsp. lemon zest
2 lbs. powdered sugar
1/4 tsp. fresh lime juice
1/4 tsp. fresh lemon juice
1/4 cup plus 1 Tbsp. Maraschino cherry juice
24 Maraschino cherries with stems
drinking straws

Preheat oven to 325 F. Drain cherries, reserving juice for frosting. Cut cherries in half (if not using cherry halves already); dry cherries thoroughly. Sift flour and baking powder together. Coat cherries with a little of the dry mixture; set aside. In mixing bowl, cream butter and sugar; add eggs, one at a time, mixing well. Add vanilla, lemon and lime

juice; combine well. Add dry mix, milk and cherry juice alternately and beat until batter is smooth. Fill cupcake liners 1/2 full with batter; drop in cherries (approximately 4 in each cupcake). Fill the remainder of the cupcake liner with batter, almost to the top of liner. Bake for 25-28 minutes, until toothpick inserted comes out clean. Cool completely on wire rack before icing. **FROSTING:** Cream butter and shortening until light and fluffy. Add lime and lemon zest, mix. Alternately add powdered sugar and fruit juices. Beat until smooth and creamy. Add more cherry juice, if needed, to reach desired consistency; frost cupcakes. If desired, pipe frosting onto cupcake with a large star decorating tip. Top each cupcake with a stemmed Maraschino cherry. For an additional fun decoration, cut drinking straws into thirds and push one straw piece into the top of each cupcake.



Scan It for Health

What is the big deal about osteoporosis anyway? Our TV shows are inundated with commercials of the latest and greatest medication to take for this problem. If you are female and over 50, your physician frequently encourages you to have a bone scan. Is it important to have a Bone Mineral Density Test? In a word, yes.

Osteoporosis means porous bones. Porous bones are less solid or less dense and become more fragile; therefore, they are more prone to fracture. This disease is a silent one in that it has no symptoms. Usually, you will not know if you have it until a bone breaks and a closer examination is made. Typically, as you grow older, your bones become weaker. Older females are more likely to get this disease than men are. Women also lose bone rapidly after menopause. Estrogen, in conjunction with other hormones and minerals, works to build bone. When a woman becomes post-menopausal, that building block is compromised and bones are at risk to thinning and breakage.

Other risk factors include your family history. If a member of your family suffers from this affliction, you are more

likely to get the disease. A sedentary lifestyle also increases your risk. Exercising places more stress on your bones, which sends a signal to them to increase bone mass. The more active you were as a child, the greater chance you have of building up strong bones, lessening your risk of developing osteoporosis. Your "bone bank" is off to a good start.

The importance of calcium and Vitamin D in your diet cannot be underestimated. Your body needs calcium for more functions than simply being a necessary ingredient for bones and teeth. When the calcium level in your blood drops, your body will take the calcium it needs from bones. As your diet supplies additional calcium, the proper amount is restored to the bones. Most adults and teenagers do not get the daily requirement of calcium from their diet, so a calcium supplement is necessary. Vitamin D aids with the absorption of calcium and helps to regulate the amount of calcium in your blood. Vitamin D can be obtained through supplements, diet or exposure to at least 10 minutes of sunlight every day.

Becoming stronger is all up to you. With appropriate exercise, watching your weight, a diet rich in calcium or supplements, and foods or supplements fortified with Vitamin D, osteoporosis is a disease you can live with. Your physician will help you determine how much calcium and Vitamin D you need and whether you need additional medication. Get your Bone Mineral Density Test! **NOW**






